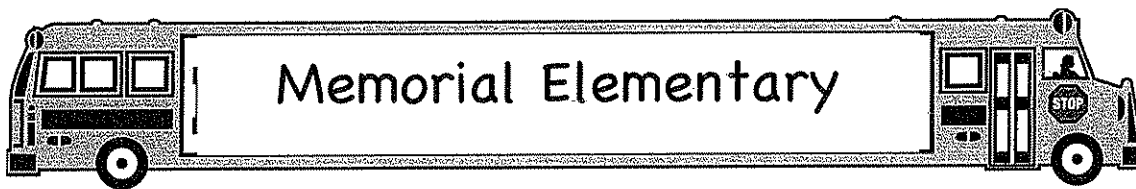

On Thursday, August 26, 2010 the Kindergarten Center at Hanover Green hosted an orientation night for new students and parents. The students and parents met with Ms. Pecaitis and the classroom teachers. The evening gave the students a chance to get acquainted with their teacher. It also gave parents the opportunity to ask any questions they might have had. The evening ended with refreshments served by the cafeteria staff.

The first few days of school went well. The students are adjusting. A lot of time has been spent learning rules and routines.(SWEBS) Each classroom and the school as a whole implemented the SPIRIT behavior program. Classes have been working hard to earn SPIRIT cards so that their classroom can earn the most SPIRIT cards to be the winner for classroom behavior.

We began introducing each letter of the alphabet. Using the Handwriting Without Tears program, students practice their letters on a daily basis. Teachers are implementing Reading Thru the 21 day planner and students are reciting nursery rhymes. In Math class we have been learning position words and soon will begin learning the numbers one through ten and patterns.

The CEO initiated the season by having the children experiencing veggies and fruits with a tasting program in the cafeteria.

With the weather cooperating, students have been participating in physical education class outdoors. Besides physical education, the students have been engaging in some creative art projects.

The end of September our students celebrated Constitution Day/Citizenship day. We also acknowledged the first day of Fall and Johnny Appleseed's birthday.
