The month of November for the kindergartners at Hanover Green Kindergarten Center was filled with various activities. CEO presented lessons on grains and R.I.F. distribution was held on November 5<sup>th</sup>. The Child Study Team met on November 9<sup>th</sup> and the PTA meeting was held that very same evening. Santa visited the Center on November 18<sup>th</sup> for pictures and Parent-teacher conferences were held on Tuesday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, and Friday November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

In the classrooms, students continue to learn the letters of the alphabet .The practice of the sounds /s/, /p/, /t/ and /i/ help students to remember the letters s, p, t and i. Students also continue to take home books with the high frequency words that we are working on to read to parents.

In math class, the students continue to count and compare numbers 0-10 and 11-31 in Chapter 5 with the help of the story "One Fine Day." Students were introduced to the concepts of more and fewer, counting backwards and forwards, skip counting by two's and fives. These concepts will continually be reviewed throughout the year.

In other classroom happenings, students continue to practice handwriting with the assistance of Handwriting Without Tears and all the manipulatives including wooden pieces, songs, and small chalkboards. Science lessons continue to focus on the trees and leaves. Students completed leaf rubbings, puzzles, and journal entries. Social Studies lessons focused on Families and How to Get Along with Others. Students made heart collages of members of their family and finger puppets to practice courteous speaking and listening.

Hanover Green Kindergarten students collected canned goods for the CEO Weinberg Food drive as part of the areas Feed A Friend Program for Thanksgiving. It was a huge success.
